The 2014 year is coming to an end and it is a pleasure to send you our Holiday Seasons greetings and our best wishes for 2015.

Next year will be a special year for our Association as we will organize the King Leopold III Challenge at the moment of the celebration of the 200th anniversary of the battle of Waterloo. We have thus decided to play on courses near by the battlefield and have selected three "Royal" courses as usual.

The programme will start on Tuesday 14th of July at the Royal Waterloo Golf Club by the traditional competition Europe vs United States and by a warming up practice for the other players. At the end of the day, a cocktail party and an historical view on the battle will await you.

On Wednesday 15th of July, the first matches of the King Leopold Challenge will be played in 4 BBB on the Marache course of the Royal Waterloo Golf Club. On Thursday, greensomes will take place at the Royal Golf Club de Belgique in Ravenstein, where a dinner party will gather all the participants in the evening. The last matches will be played in singles on the "Lion" course of the Royal Waterloo overlooking the battlefield.

We are happy to inform you that the visited golf clubs will allow the accompanying ladies to play.

All these Clubs own few golf cars and their use is very strictly limited. Trolleys will of course be available.

Your Association is invited to enter 2 teams of 4 players to this competition, as the total number of participants may not exceed 120 players.

Would you kindly confirm your interest for participating in the King Leopold III Challenge 2015 and the exact number of teams you will enter. Subsequently we will send you a detailed entry form to fill with names and handicaps of the players, as well as the possible participation of the accompanying ladies.

Due to the battle celebrations, hotels could be busier at that time and we have negotiated favorable conditions with the hotels of the Martins organization listed in appendix. We recommend you to make early bookings. There is also an IBIS hotel in Waterloo which could be interesting at a cheaper rate.

We hope to see you in great golfing form during the coming year.
